Many Local Councils today require what is known as a Significant Landscape Overlay (SLO) as part of the building permit. The purpose of the SLO is to help identify significant landscapes and or to conserve and enhance the character of significant landscapes. A schedule to the LSO must generally contain: A statement of the nature and key elements of the landscape and also the landscape objective to be achieved. Boeders can provide all the requirements needed to ensure your LSO meets with council approval.
